RED is an interactive communications and scheduling platform which allows administrators and staff to schedule their events and ensure that **all participants are notified** if something changes—seamlessly and instantly. Anyone can subscribe to the Saints Peter and Paul network on RED and can be in control of the information they wish to receive and in what manner, whether it's e-mail, text, Facebook, Twitter, etc. Also, you can automatically sync your devices and have the events populated to your calendar.

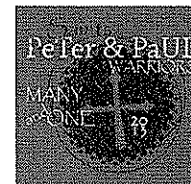

If you already have a RED account through Boonville R-1 Schools, all you need do is log in, click on "Manage My Alerts" and then click on the red "Add Network" button. Scroll down through the list to add Saints Peter and Paul. **Please create your account as soon as possible as the school will be discontinuing shortly the current text messaging system.**
